We still have a few things to do and a very short time to do it.

This year has been a trying year for all of us. As for the Alumni Association, we too have felt the hardships the economic problems are causing. Attendance at the banquet last June was very low and the dance even lower than years past. Unfortunately, when there is low attendance we do not secure the funds needed to cover costs for Alumni Day activities. Last June, due to the low attendance and keeping the cost of the dinner to a minimum we were concerned. It wasn't until 9pm,

when we had a surge of 20 or so alum join us for the dance, that we finally covered expenses.

As we prepare for the festivities for June 2009, we worry that these tough economic times may have an even greater effect on the attendance this year. We certainly understand that attending the banquet and dance are a low priority especially for those of you who would have to travel. Family, self and home come first. Please know that we are looking into a variety of ways to shave some cost off the banquet tickets and encourage your input. We have had several suggestions regarding banquet/meeting and dance.

- Eliminate the banquet-hold a meeting prior to the dance offering snacks.
- Eliminate the banquet and just hold a meeting right after the parade.
- Eliminate the dance-giving class can meet wherever they choose to do so.
- Move back to the Inn at Fireside Suites (far more expensive than the Legion)

We will forge ahead this year with no change in schedule for the day and we will continue to prepare for the banquet/meeting and dance to follow. As we do so, we urge you to join us at the Legion and ask that you encourage your classmates to do the same. If you are convinced that there is no way your absence would have an impact... remember that the difference between taking a loss and breaking even was the cost of 20 dance tickets last June.

PARADE RULES AND REGULATIONS

(including NEW judging requirements)

The parade chairperson is Denise Dennis Shibles.
Register floats by calling 603-448-1315 or
email Denise.D.Shibles@hitchcock.org.

1. In order to be judged, floats should be registered by June 1, 2009.
First come, first registered.
Floats not registered by the June 1st deadline are still welcome.
2. Floats are to enter at the Village Pizza side from 9:30-10:00am lining up on the left side.
****ONLY FLOATS WILL BE ALLOWED IN THE LINE-UP AREA.****
Participants do not need to arrive until 10:45am when judging will begin.
3. Classes are required to have their theme and year of graduation on the front of the float.
4. There will be NO DRINKING OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES on or around the floats at any time before or during the parade. This is grounds for immediate disqualification.
5. NOTHING IS TO BE THROWN FROM THE FLOATS. Participants walking alongside their float may toss candy into the crowd.
6. All floats are to be judged in the following areas:
 - A. Appearance:
 1. Quality (10pts.)
Handmade (5pts) costumes, signs, decorations, furniture
Finished Look (5pts.) painted, no rough edges, overall coverage of trailer
 2. Action (10 pts.)
Technology (5pts.) water, mechanics, lights, sound
Class energy (5pts.) actions appropriate to theme, continuous throughout parade, having fun
 - B. How well theme is carried out:
 1. to parade theme (5pts.)
 2. to your float theme (5pts.)

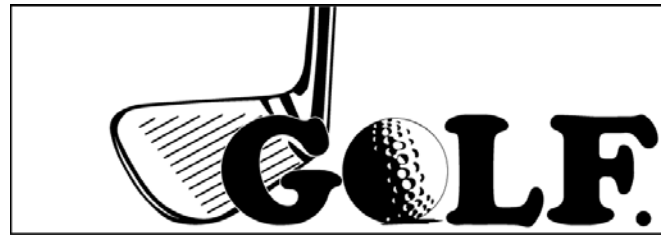

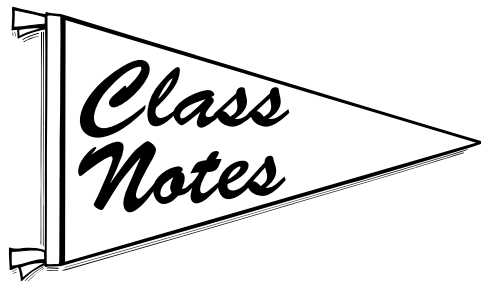

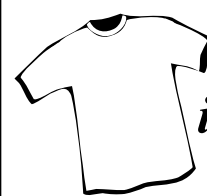
